Bike Share Pittsburgh Experience

Bike Share Pittsburgh has a shared open office space located near the Doughboy statue on the 33rd block of Penn Avenue in the Strip District. We have a mix of folks working remotely, in-person, and hybrid schedules depending on job requirements. The staff is small, so each role at Bike Share Pittsburgh requires focus, hard work, and (most importantly!) teamwork to provide our customers with a joyful experience riding bikes. We *all* take pride in POGOH. In our downtime, we ride bikes and spend time supporting others in our community.

POSITION DESCRIPTION:

Bike Share Pittsburgh seeks a highly motivated Events Manager to advance POGOH's event calendar and outreach initiatives as well as manage part-time, seasonal outreach representatives. This person will be responsible for the development of POGOH's event calendar, the design and implementation of successful events that grow awareness and ridership of POGOH, and manage the Pittsburgh Bike People outreach team. The right candidate will be enthusiastic about connecting with POGOH riders and Pittsburgh community members, and able to frequently attend meetings and events on evenings and weekends.

DUTIES & RESPONSIBILITIES:

Event Management

- Assist the Director of Marketing & Community Outreach in setting strategy and goals for all of POGOH's events
- Organize and support all of POGOH's annual events from planning through implementation



- Explore opportunities to strategically expand event offerings
- Identify partner event opportunities
- Create, test, and evaluate event engagement tools
- Evaluate event performance and create event reports

Outreach & Engagement:

- Manage the Pittsburgh Bike People, a team of 15+ seasonal employees who represent both POGOH and BikePGH at community Events throughout the city
- Attend outreach events throughout the city
- Develop strategies and implement projects that enhance community engagement

- A minimum of 3 years of experience in event planning and coordination

- Culturally aware and comfortable working with diverse populations and stakeholders across the city
- Understanding of structural barriers to equitable participation in biking and bikeshare
- Able to lift and move 50lbs
- Hand-eye coordination and manual dexterity are needed to set up tables, chairs, tents
- Able to ride a bicycle
- Proficiency with Google and Microsoft Suites
